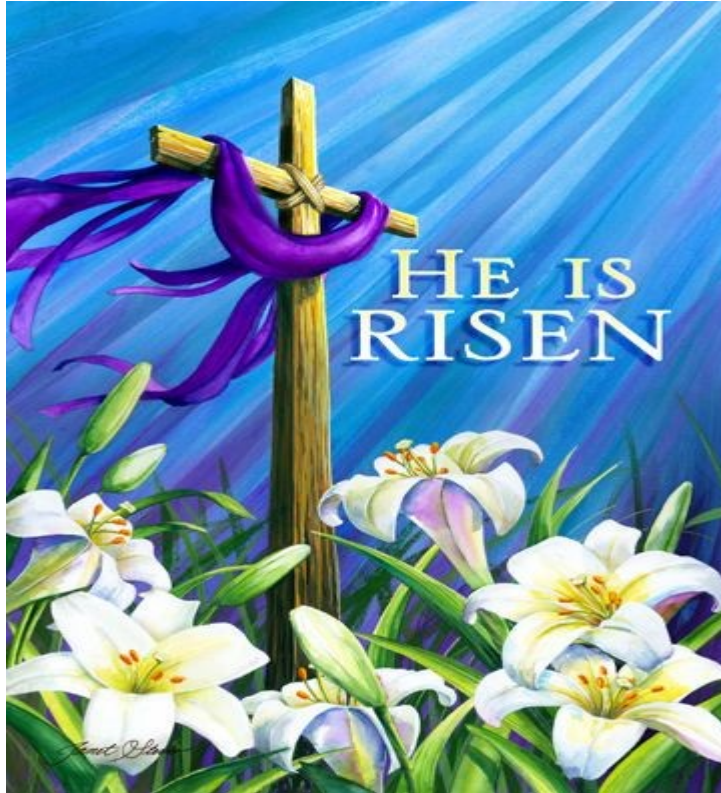

Dear Family members in Christ,

“Alleluia: “The Lord is Risen from the Dead” “Alleluia” !

Easter means “fresh flowers” or spring. We are almost there!

We had a good celebration of the Holy week, good participation for palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

Today we commemorate the great feast of Resurrection” - the high point of our faith. Every Sunday is a risen Lord's feast. Resurrection is the foundation of our faith. As St Paul says “ If Christ has not been raised , the our preaching is in vain, and your faith is in vain” 1Cor 15:4.
