Every year second Sunday of May we celebrate Mother's day. The history of mother's Day is centuries old and goes back to the times of ancient Greeks, who held festivities to honor Rhea, the mother of the gods. In 1872 Julia Ward Howe organized a day for mothers dedicated to peace and disarmament. In 1907, Anna M. Jarvis, a Philadelphia school teacher, began a movement to set up a national Mother's day in honor of her mother, Anna Maria Reeves Jarvis. In the year 1914 president Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the Second Sunday in May as a national Holiday in honor of mothers.

She has built something more magnificent than any cathedral—a dwelling for an immortal soul, the tiny perfection of her baby's body . . . The angels have not been blessed with such a grace.
