The Ascension walk-out: There was a long-winded pastor who preached salvation history from Genesis to Revelation in every sermon. On the feast of Ascension as he reached the book of the prophet Isaiah, he remarked that the prophet said nothing about the Ascension of Our Lord. He asked his audience, “What shall we do with him?” One old man in the front seat said, “He can have my seat, Father, I am leaving.”

Each Sunday we profess through the Creed, "He ascended into heaven." And seated at the right hand of God"

What is ascension: *After completing his mission on earth Jesus ascended into Heaven. He is returning to Father”.*

**The feast of the Ascension seems to be more about the apostles going out than Jesus going up!**

A priest Walter Cizek by name , was in Russia for 23 years, five of which were spent in the dreaded Lubyanka prison in Moscow and ten

of which were spent in harsh Siberian slave labor camp. He was finally released from Russia in 1963, in exchange for two Soviet spies held in USA. He died in 1984 at the age of 84. After release he wrote a book “**He Leadth Me**” In this book he tries to answer the question: How did you manage to survive in Russia? He **says “I was able to endure the inhuman conditions in which I found myself because I experienced somehow the presence of God. I never lost faith that God was with me, even in the worst of circumstances”.**

What was true of Fr. Walter Cizek is true of us . God still use us like the Apostles to continue the mission he started.

***Stewardship:***
